Il Trittico is an operatic treat: a rare chance to see three one-act operas performed together. With each opera presenting its own significant demands, Puccini's triptych is rarely performed together. Always seeking human stories, Puccini wanted to explore contrast, pouring his talent into the gritty melodrama of Il tabarro, the intimate tragedy of Suor Angelica and the surprising satire of Gianni Schicchi.

Constantine Costi, Imara Savage and Shaun Rennie are all making names for themselves in the Sydney opera and theatre scene. These outstanding Australian directors combine and contrast their talents to each bring you one of the operas of *Il Trittico*. Audition Brief & Information

This production recognises the diversity of the Australian performing community, and we seek to foster a more realistic and more creative representation of Australia on our stages. To this end, we strongly encourage applications from performers of varied experiences, perspectives and circumstances including performers from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds and performers with disabilities. All ethnicities are encouraged to submit an application.

Barge Workers x 3 - Il Tabarro

- Male Presenting
- To play 30 60 year olds (all ages encouraged to apply)

Organ Grinder & Buoso-Dual Role: Il Tabarro & Gianni Schicchi + COVER

- Male Presenting
- To play 40 80 year old (all ages encouraged to apply) in either role.
- Physically agile (please indicate if you have any movement/stunt experience).
- Buoso Specific details Although technically dead, this role is the comedic centre of the Gianni Schicchi plot (think *Weekend at Bernie's*). This role requires a lot of physical contact, with someone who is comfortable with physical comedy. Applicants would need to be willing to (at times) to only wear underwear onstage.

Please Note:

- 1. Artists should be available for the entire period. Any restrictions must be noted in the submission.
- 2. All actors must be Sydney based for the duration of the contract.
- 3. The Organ Grinder & Buono duel role may be split if required. This will be decided during the casting process.
